
Bras d'Or Biosphere: Population Characteristics



The geography in green represents the dissemination blocks totally contained in and bordering the Bras d'Or Biosphere. Statistics Canada defines a dissemination block (DB) as an area bounded by roads and/or boundaries of standard geographic areas. Dissemination blocks are the smallest geographic area for which population and dwelling counts are provided.

Population characteristics of dissemination blocks in the Biosphere which includes the four counties of Cape Breton Island are provided in the table. 2020 population characteristics are derived from DA[dissemination area] profiles of the area. These profiles represent population characteristics within the Biosphere
