Join the Bras d'Or Lake Biosphere Region Association for a Walk through Time and explore the 2.3 km looped trail at Goat Island in the company of a local interpretive guide who will share with us the rich Mi'kmag history and culture that has thrived here for thousands of years. Highlights of this hike include the Trading post which features goods such as furs and tools, there will be drumming with Steve and traditional dancing, smudging, an exhibition of Waites, the oldest Mi'kmaq game, traditional hunting and fishing demonstrations, bread-making over an open fire and a presentation on traditional medicines. All this amid the breathtaking beauty of the Bras d'Or Lake!

The tour is approximately 2.5 hours in length and is restricted to 25 people to ensure the best experience. Cost per person if less than 15 people:

Adults - \$40.00 per person Children - \$20.00 per child

Cost per person if more than 15 people:

Adults - \$35.00 Children - \$15.00
