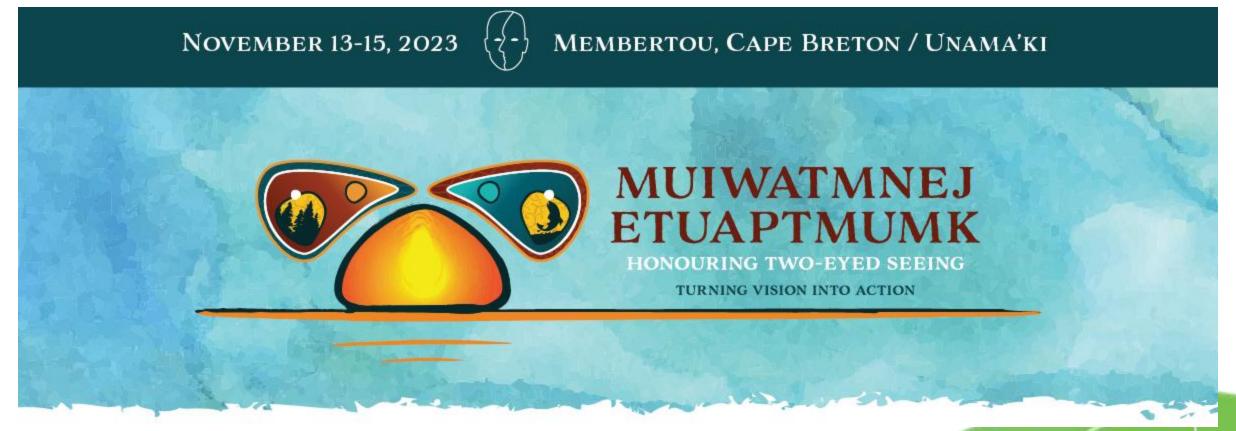

#### **By-Law Review**



#### **Article III: Membership**

- III.1. The association is member based. It actively seeks out both individuals and organizations as members to achieve shared goals.
- III.2. Membership in the Association shall be open to <u>anyone</u> <u>individuals, not</u> <u>for-profit organizations, businesses, institutions and governments</u> interested in furthering the objective of the Association.

#### **By-Law Review**



#### **By-Law I: Membership**

- i) Membership shall be open to any one individual, family, organization or business interested in furthering the objects of the Association.
- ii) Members will be admitted to the Association upon payment of a membership fee determined by the Board of Directors, and upon approval by the Board of Directors.
- iii) Each member shall be entitled to receive notice of, and attend all meetings of members and shall be entitled to one vote on any vote taken at any meeting of members.
- iv) The membership year begins on April 1 the date the individual becomes a member.
- iv) Membership fees are payable each year; a notice of the fees payable shall be sent to each member by the Association promptly before the due date.
- vi) Membership shall cease:
  - a) upon death
  - b) one month following written notice of nonpayment of annual fee.
  - c) if the member resigns by written notice to the Association.
  - d) if the member ceases to qualify for membership in accordance with these bylaws
  - e) if, by vote of the majority of members of the Association or a majority vote of the Directors of the Association at a meeting duly called and for which notice of the proposed action has been given.
- vii) Individual, Family, Organizational and Business membership fees may differ.

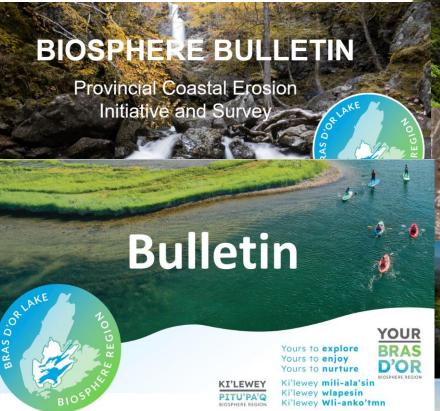

Atlantic Canada UNESCO Tourism Corridor Engagement Survey







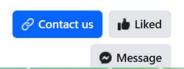


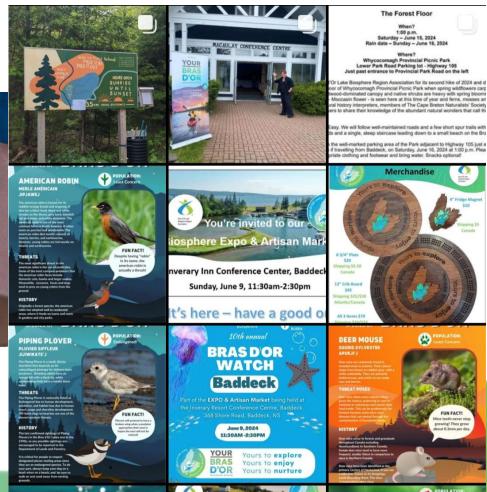
