 and Red oak, ferns, lichens

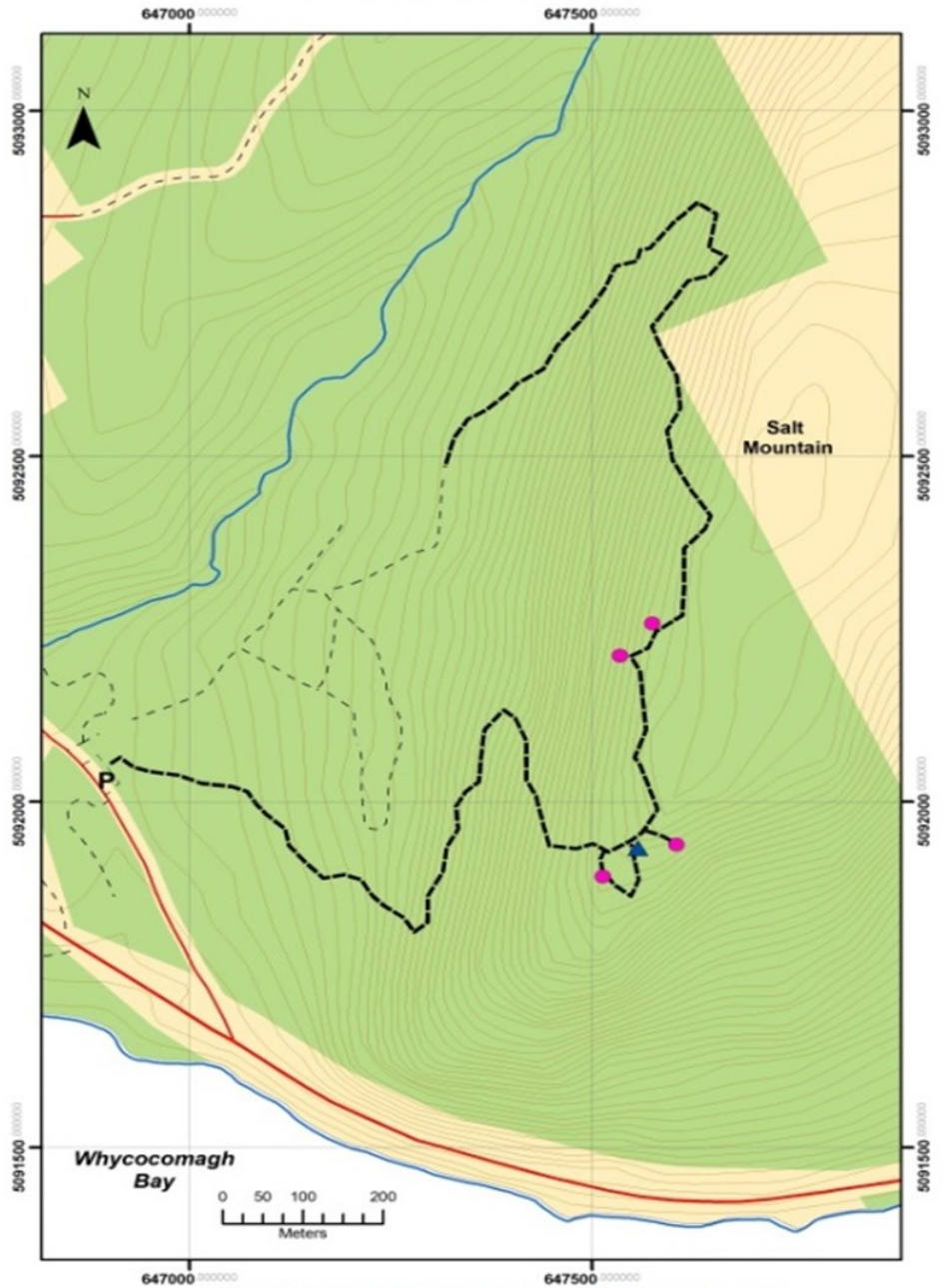
